



George D. Masten

Now serving his 8th consecutive term, George Masten was initially appointed to the Investment Board in 1985 to represent active members of the Public Employees Retirement System. Following his retirement as the executive director of the Washington Federation of State Employees, Masten was appointed in 1993 as the Board's representative for the retired members of the state's defined benefit pension fund.

Masten served as Board chair from 2003-2005. Currently, he chairs the WSIB's Private Markets Committee and is a member of the Administrative and Audit committees.

Masten was president of the Retired Public Employees Council of Washington for three years and is an active member of the local Chapter of the Retired Public Employees Council. He was director of Field Services and served as an area representative for the WFSE.

Masten also worked as a disability claims adjudicator for Washington's Department of Labor and Industries; served as a vice president of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees; and, was a member of the Washington State Labor Council Executive Board.
